Term	Definition
Virtual Learning Model	Uses computer software, the Internet, or both to deliver instruction to students in a face-to-face or digital setting.
Digital Learning Model	Virtual learning using a digital curriculum <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pre-developed purchased digital curriculum such as Apex</li> <li>• Virtual learners stay virtual even if schools go remote: Apex, Canvas, GAVS</li> </ul>
Remote Learning Model	Virtual learning using a teacher to deliver curriculum <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teacher developed instruction to replace in-person instruction</li> <li>• Students attend classes from home</li> </ul>
Hybrid Learning Model	Combines face-to-face instruction with online learning.
Asynchronous Learning	Learning that occurs independently on one's own time following clear instructions provided by the teacher.
Synchronous Learning	Learning that occurs at a set time with other students via live virtual sessions with the teacher.
Canvas	Learning management system used by students, teachers and staff.
